

Scholarship covers **25% of tuition fees for the duration of the program** and is awarded at time of program offer.

For outstanding international students applying for undergraduate and postgraduate coursework programs with a minimum GPA in previous studies of 5.5 or above on a 7 point scale or equivalent. Scholarship covers **50% of tuition fees for the duration of the program**. 3 application rounds per year.






